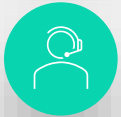

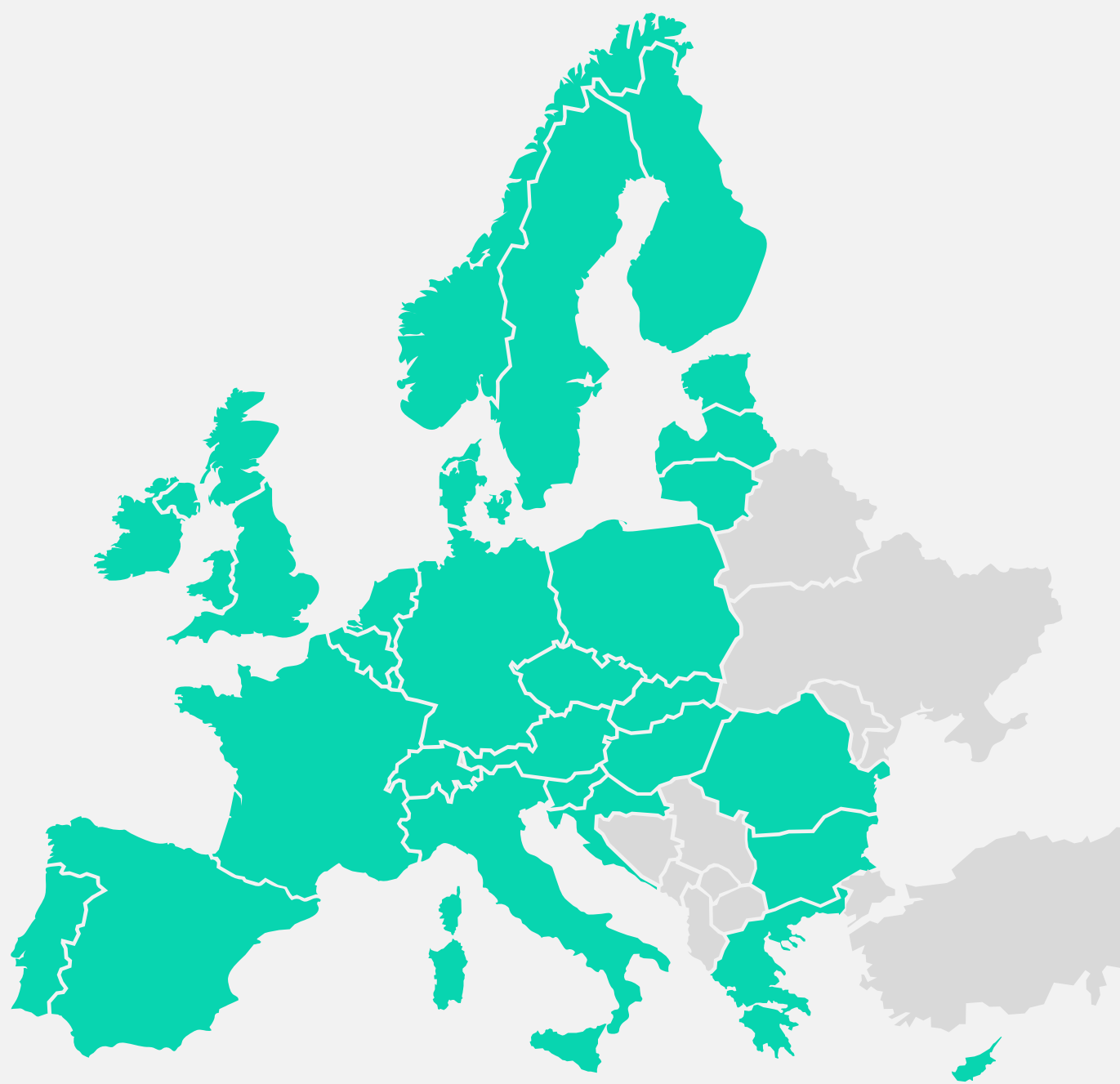



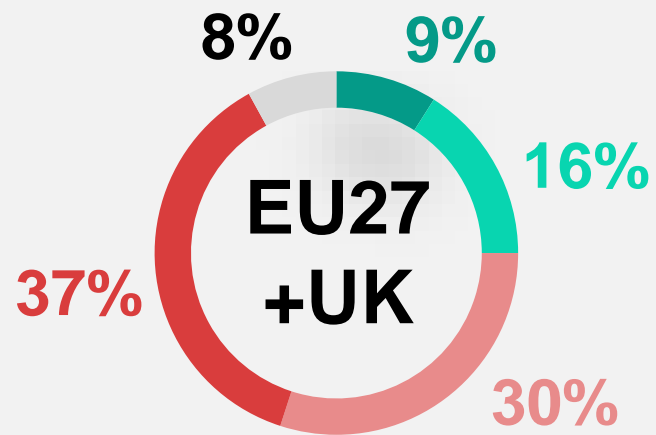

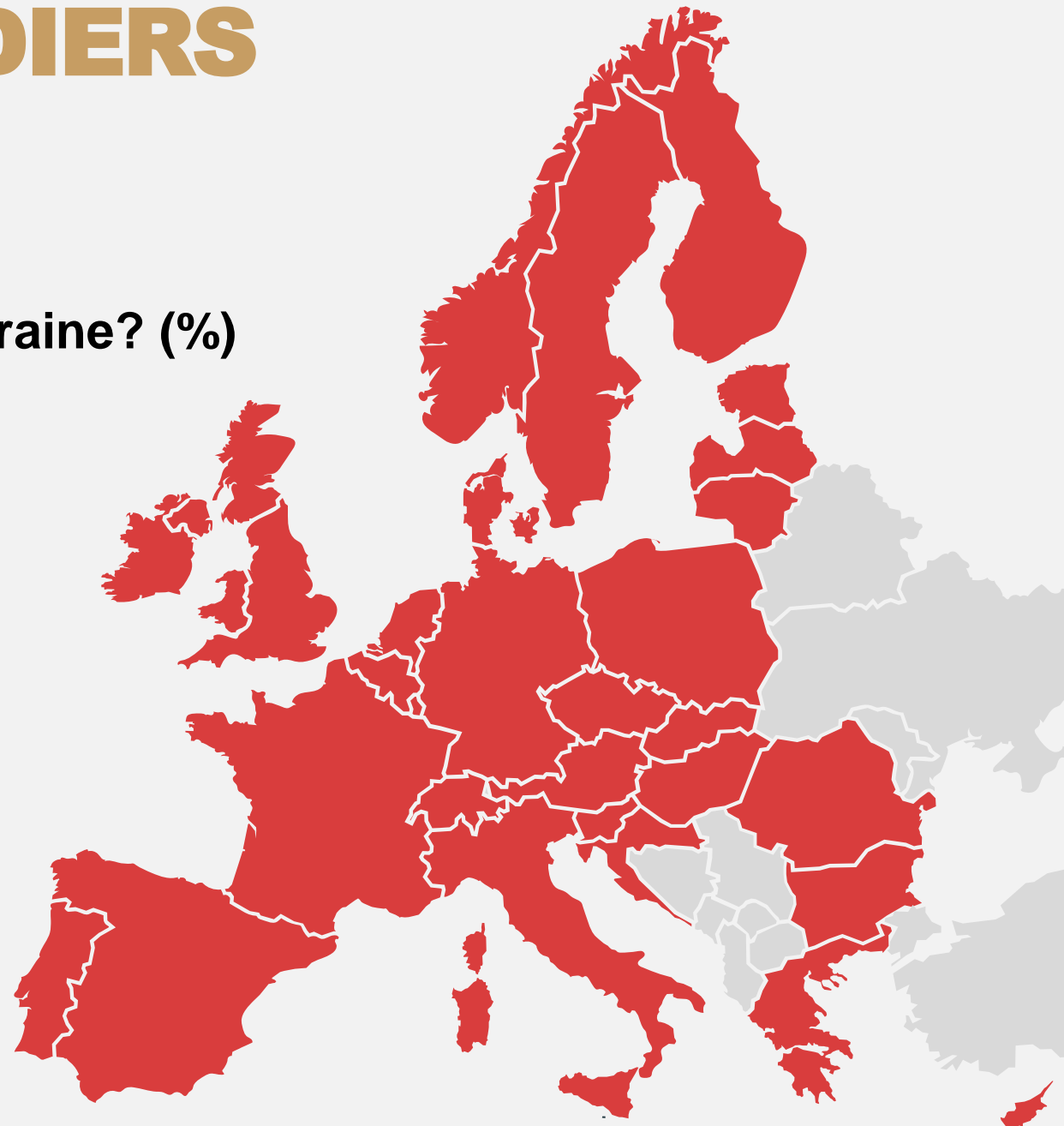

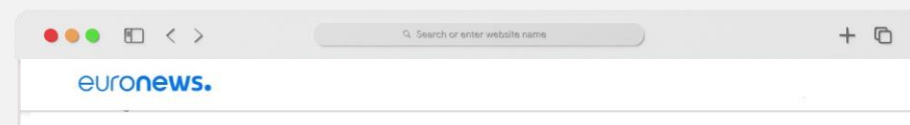

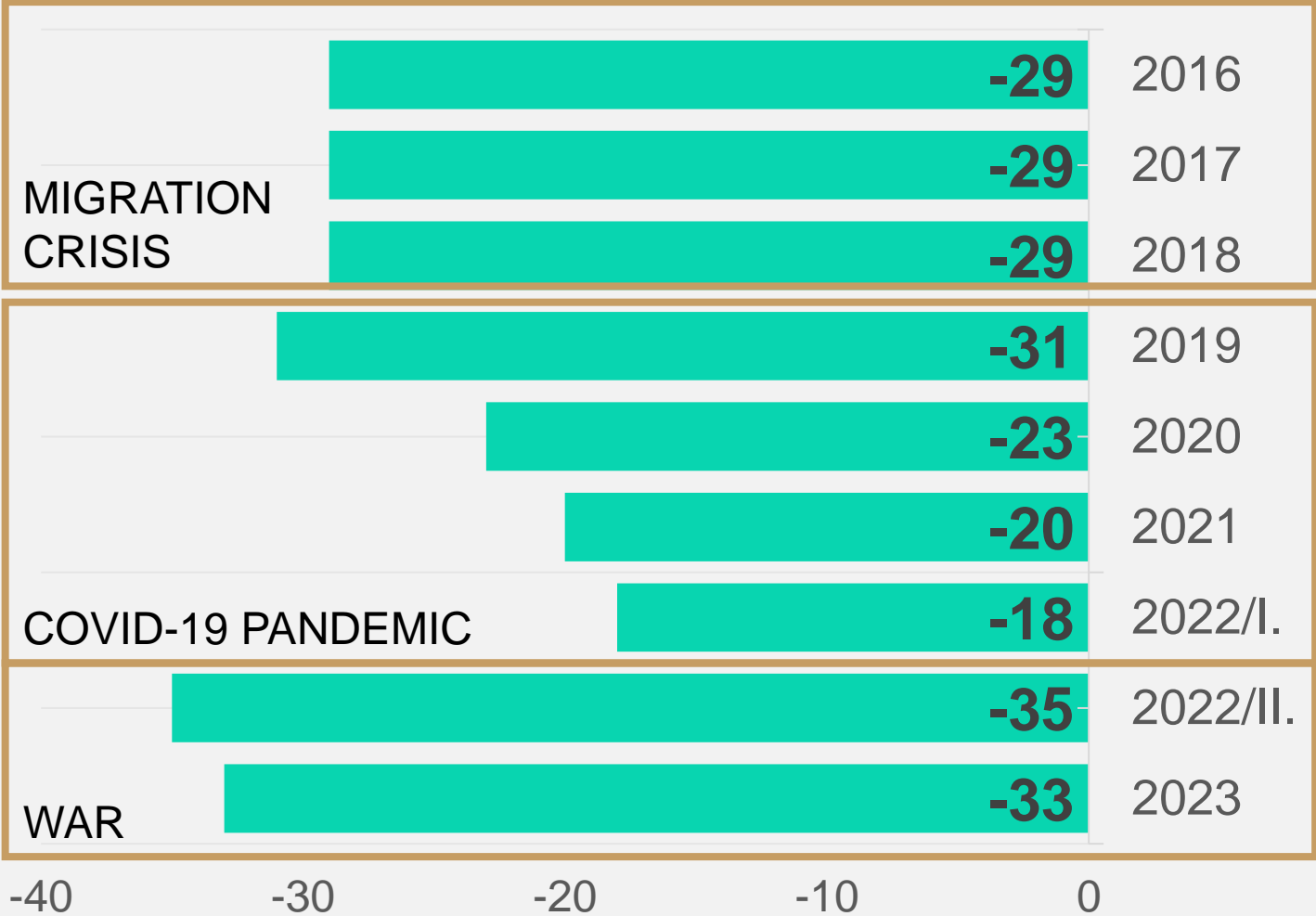

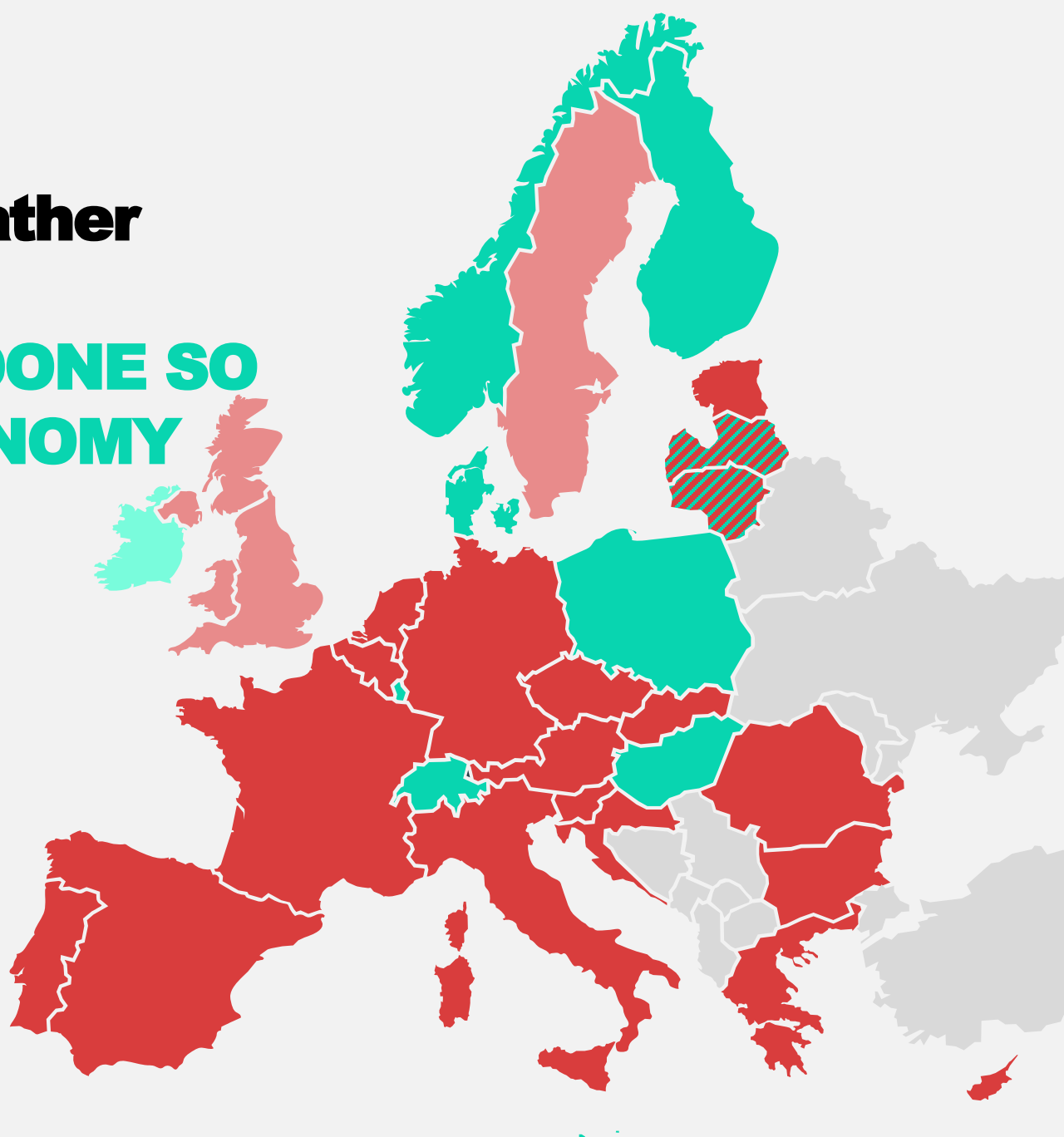

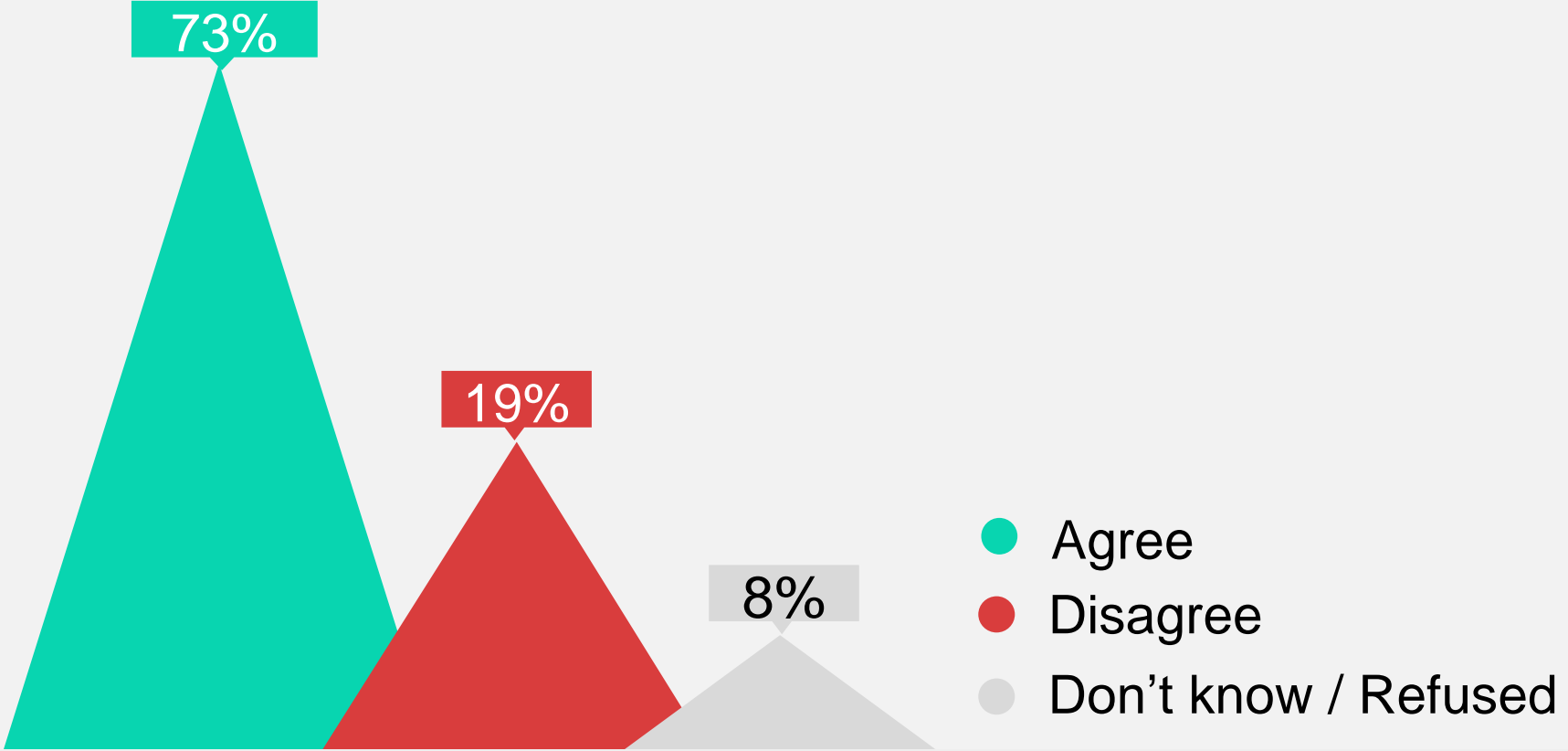


Do you rather agree or disagree that forced into peace negotiations for the war to end?(%)

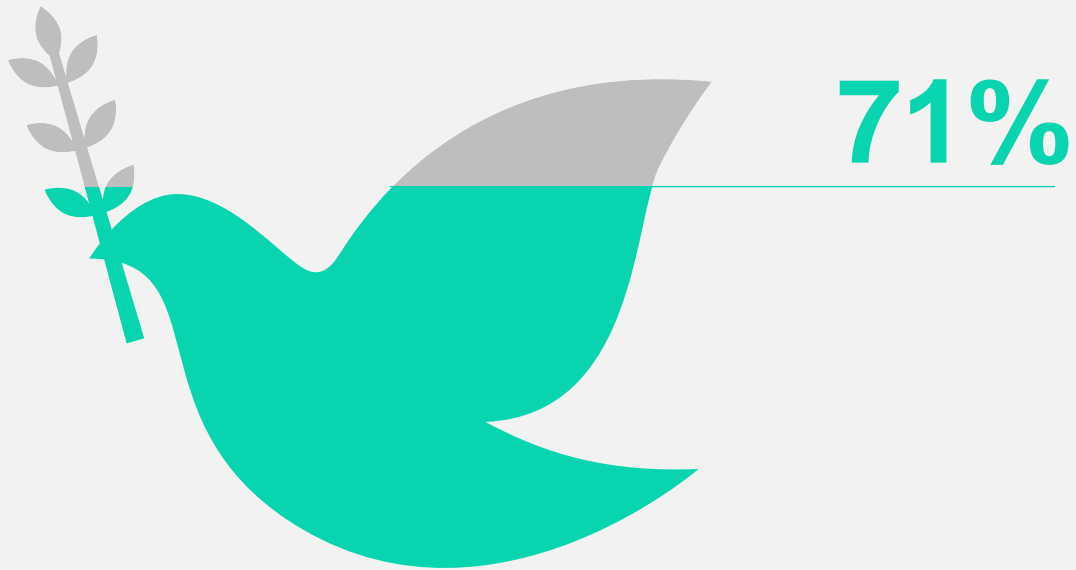

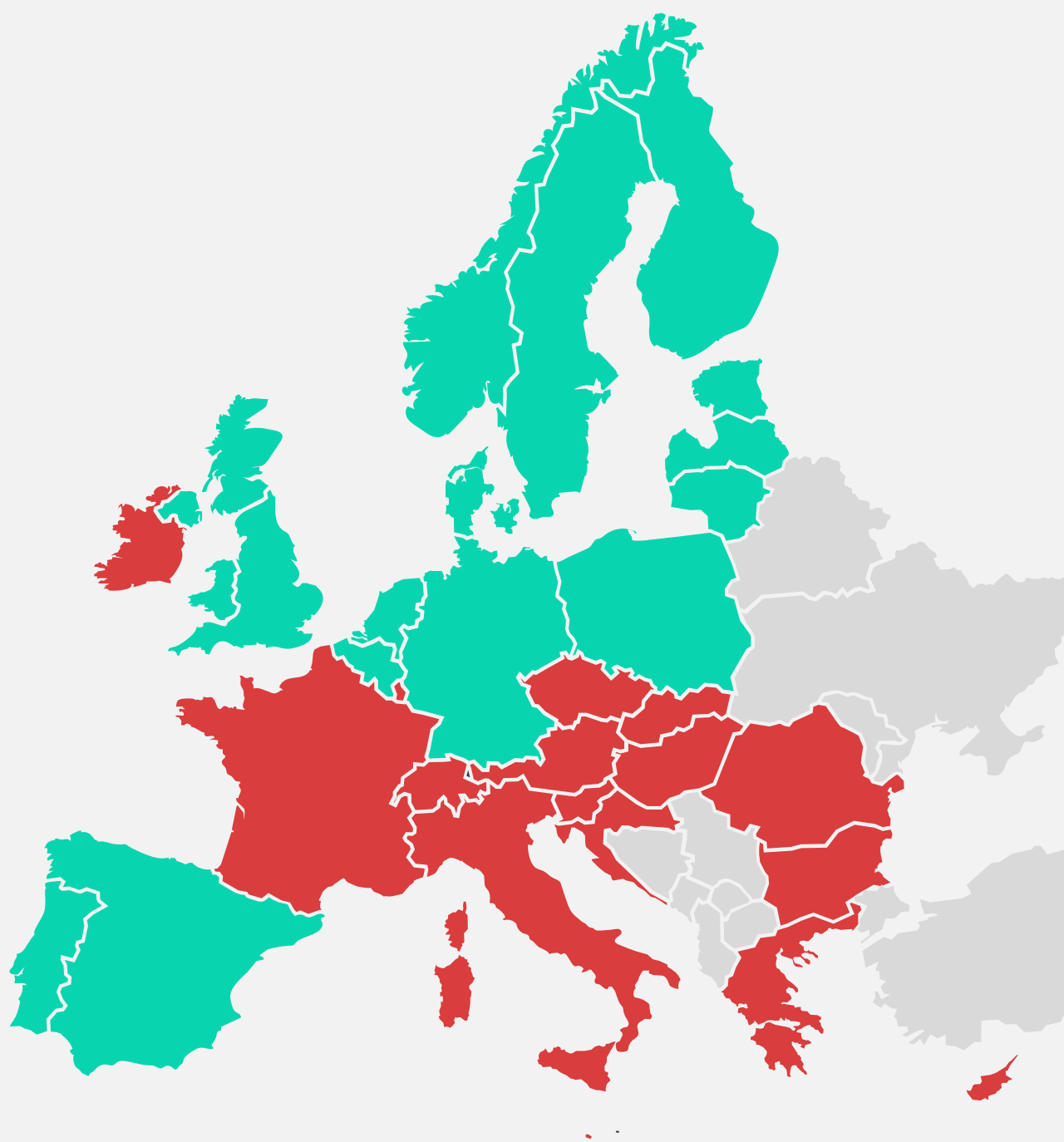

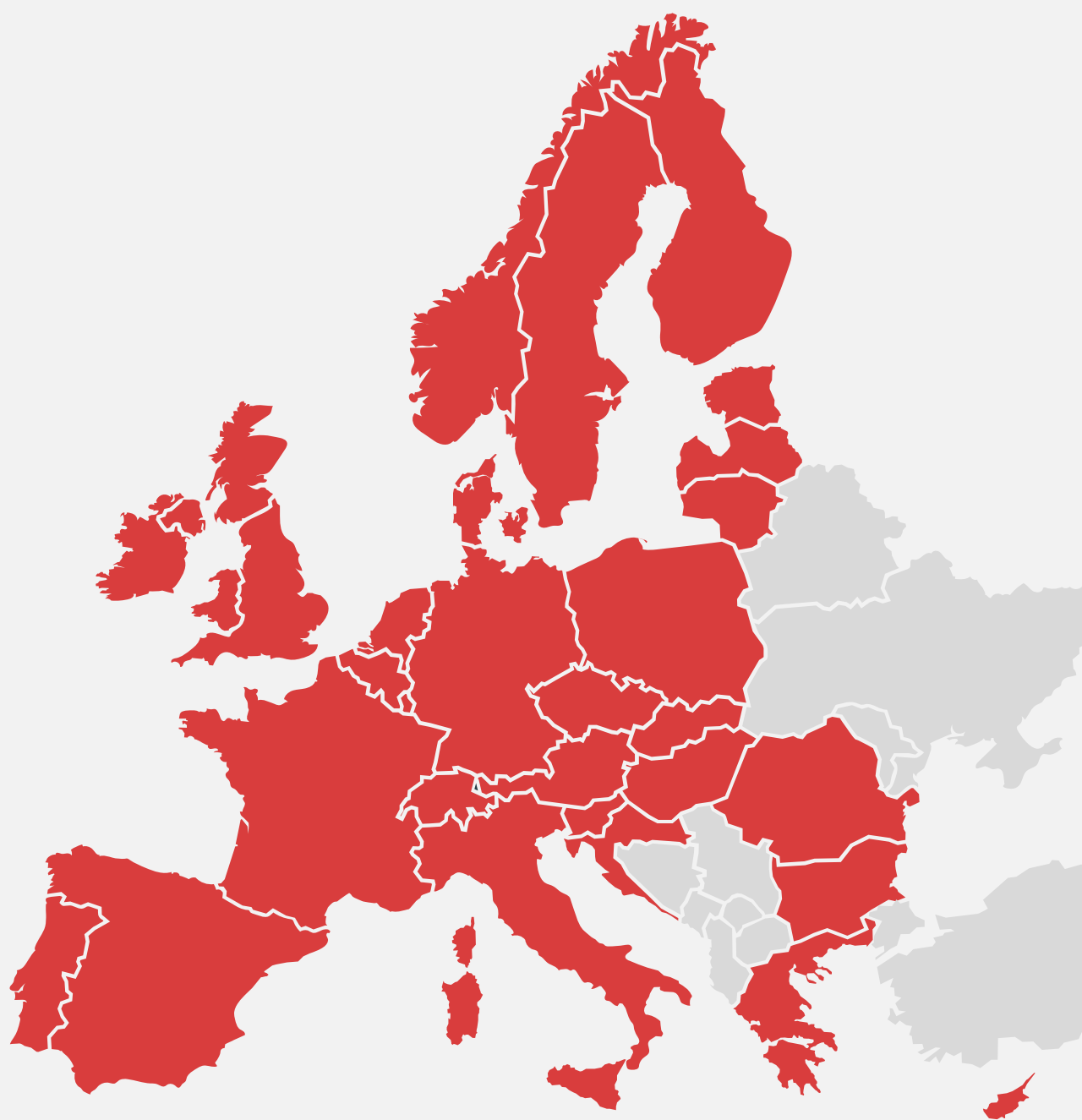

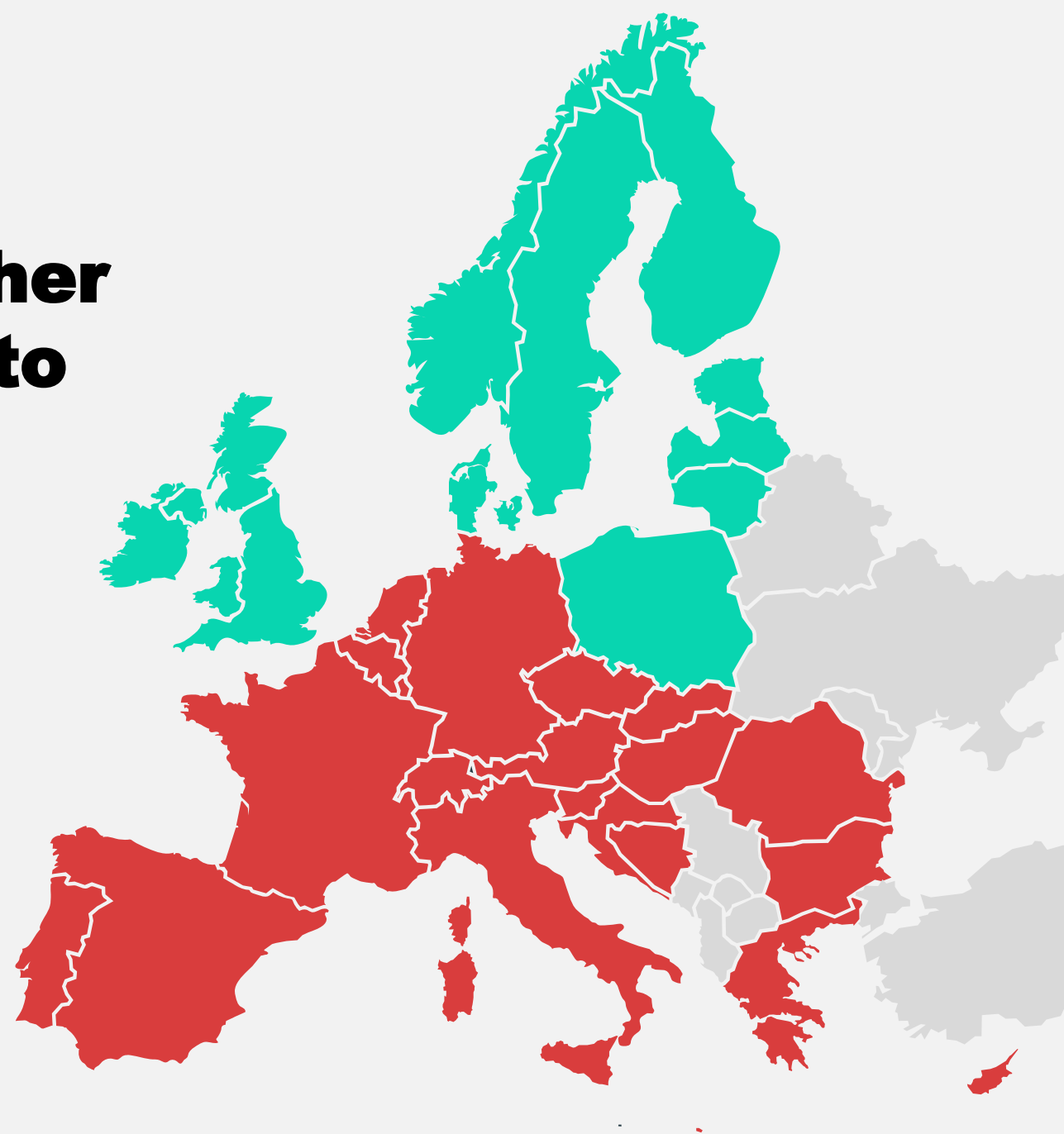

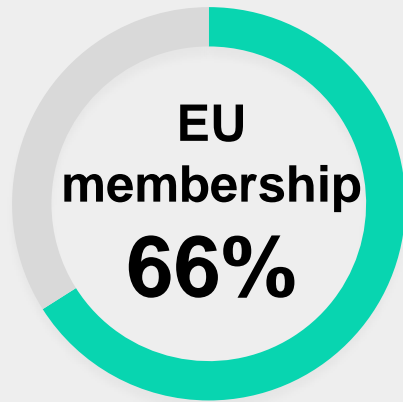

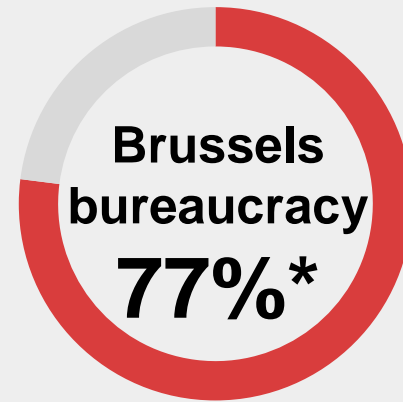

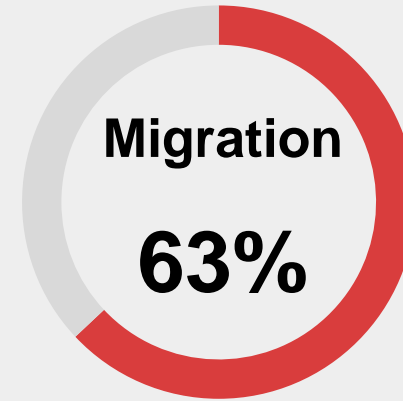

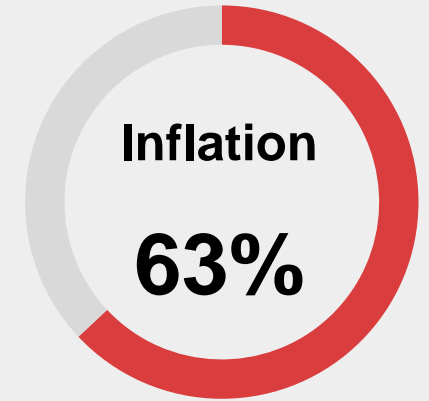


Have a negative view of Brussels bureaucracy

Are dissatisfied with Brussels' handling of the migration crisis



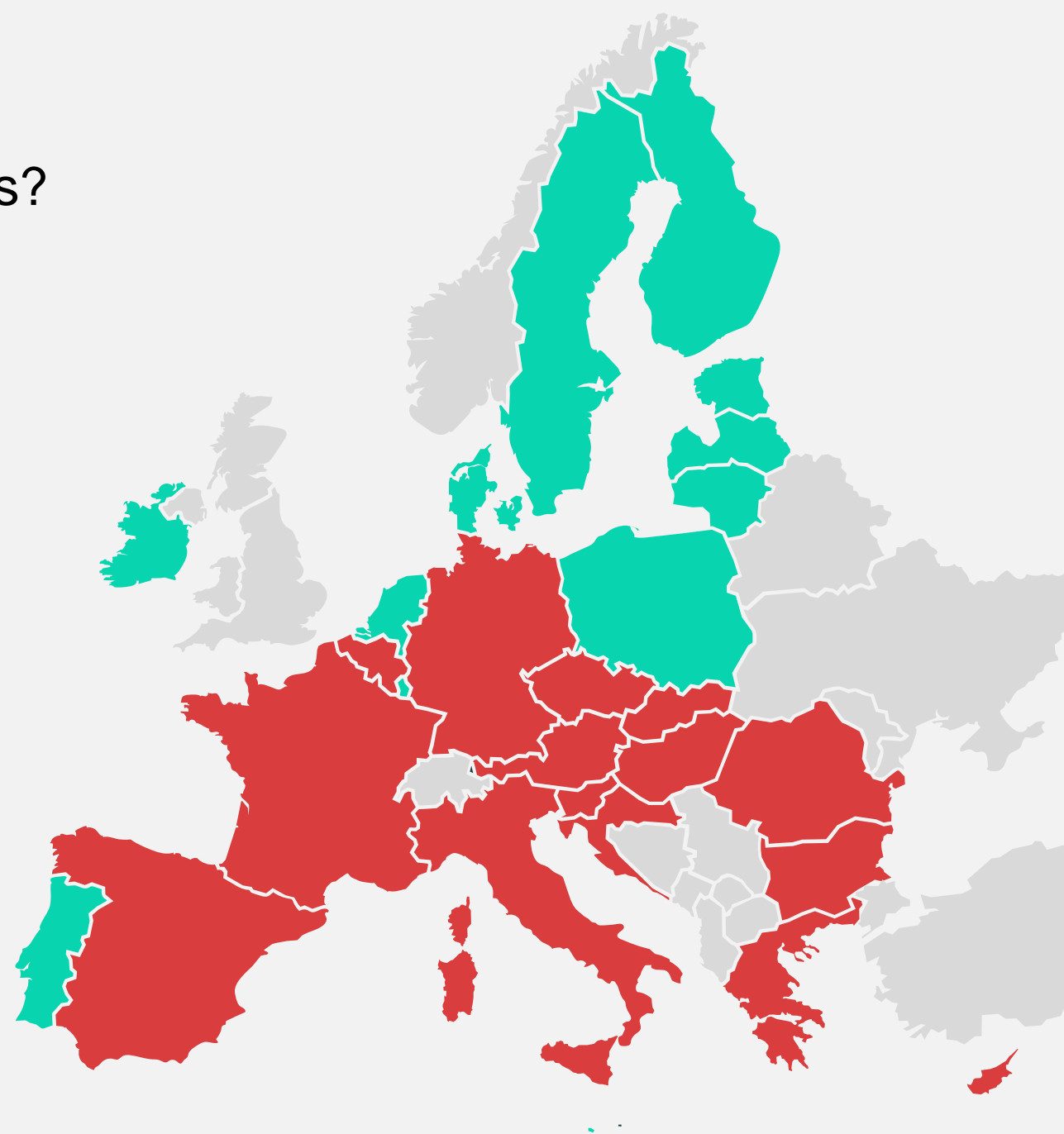
Are dissatisfied with what the EU has done to curb inflation and energy prices

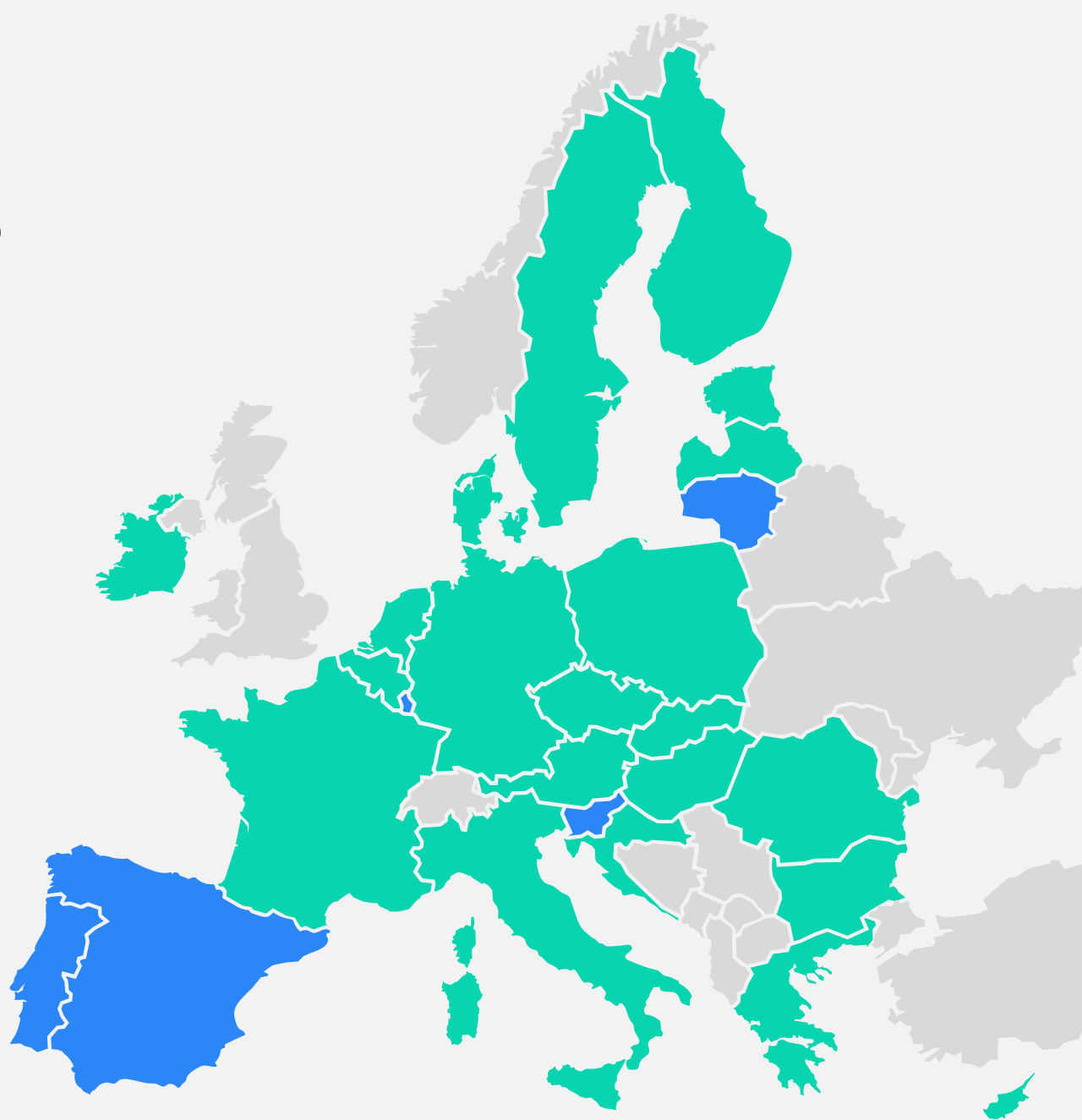

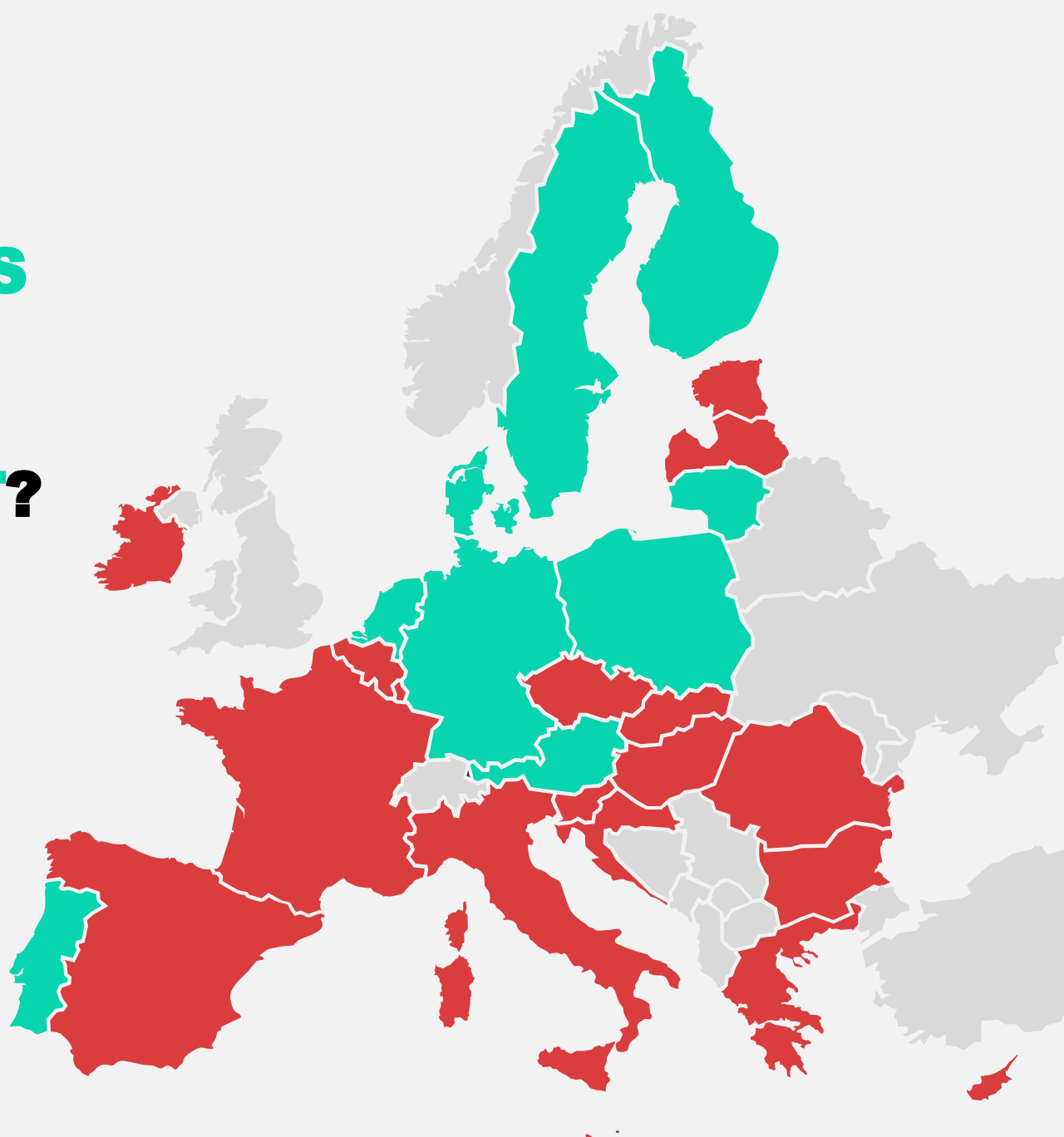

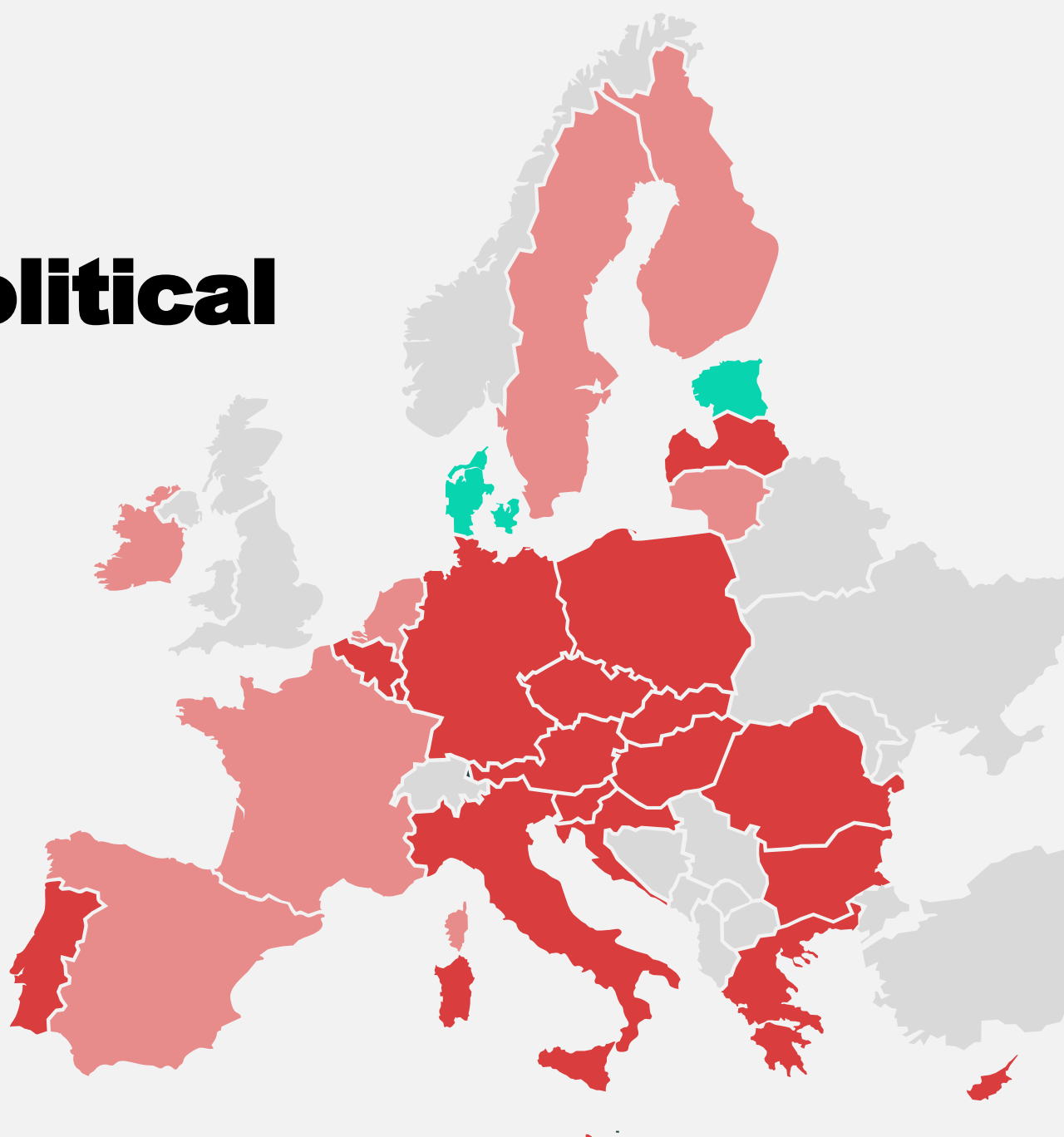
